

## **Tasks for Lithuanian activities, literature and painting**

1. Illustrating poems presented by all partner schools.

Each school should present two illustrations per each poem.(made by students). Students are given the poems of partner school (without information, which country), then illustrate what do they see, feel, how do understand from the information given in the poem, if it cause difficulties, so students can be informed about the details – country, poet, style etc.

2. To write their own story memorable story.
3. To introduce creative process:
  - 1) Diary
  - 2) To create hero instead of oneself (sex, age, race, nationality could be different)
  - 3) To move (shift) to particular space and time.
  - 4) Creating story is possible
  - 5) If student is not able to do it so just to read the novel and write impressions or analysis.

We can choose either:

Write a reflection on the novel/book every country presented.

Write a story related to teenager problems (not necessarily based on the book). It could be set in any location, time, etc.

The story length should be between one or two pages long and edited in 12 New Roman font
