

# **ACTION: "The Solidarity Wardrobe"**

## **PRELIMINARY ACTIVITIES**

### **PROCEDURE**

- Members from the school community (teachers, students, parents, etc) donate pieces of clothing.
- These pieces of clothing are taken to the Maintenance Department.
- There students from FP Básica divide into five groups, each one in charge of a specific task.

Team 1. Sorting out pieces of clothing into different categories.

Team 2. Wash clothes.

Team 3. Hang them up for drying

Team 4. Sew torn clothes

Team 5. Iron clothes and put them in shelves in their appropriate category (women, children, men, others)

- Students pack the clothes and label the boxes before they take them to the "solidarity wardrobe".

### **IN THE SOLIDARITY WARDROBE.**

Students carry out a survey to find out information about the work developed by the brotherhood in the so-called "solidarity wardrobe".

## **Questions**

- What do you do with the pieces of clothing that we bring here?
- Are there any other institutions (other schools, associations, etc...) that contribute to your work in the "solidarity wardrobe"?
- Is there any particular piece of clothing you are more interested in?
- Apart from clothes, do you collect any other objects?
- What kind of people are the recipients of the clothes you collect?
- How long have you been doing this job?
- What is your opinion of our initiative with your institution?
